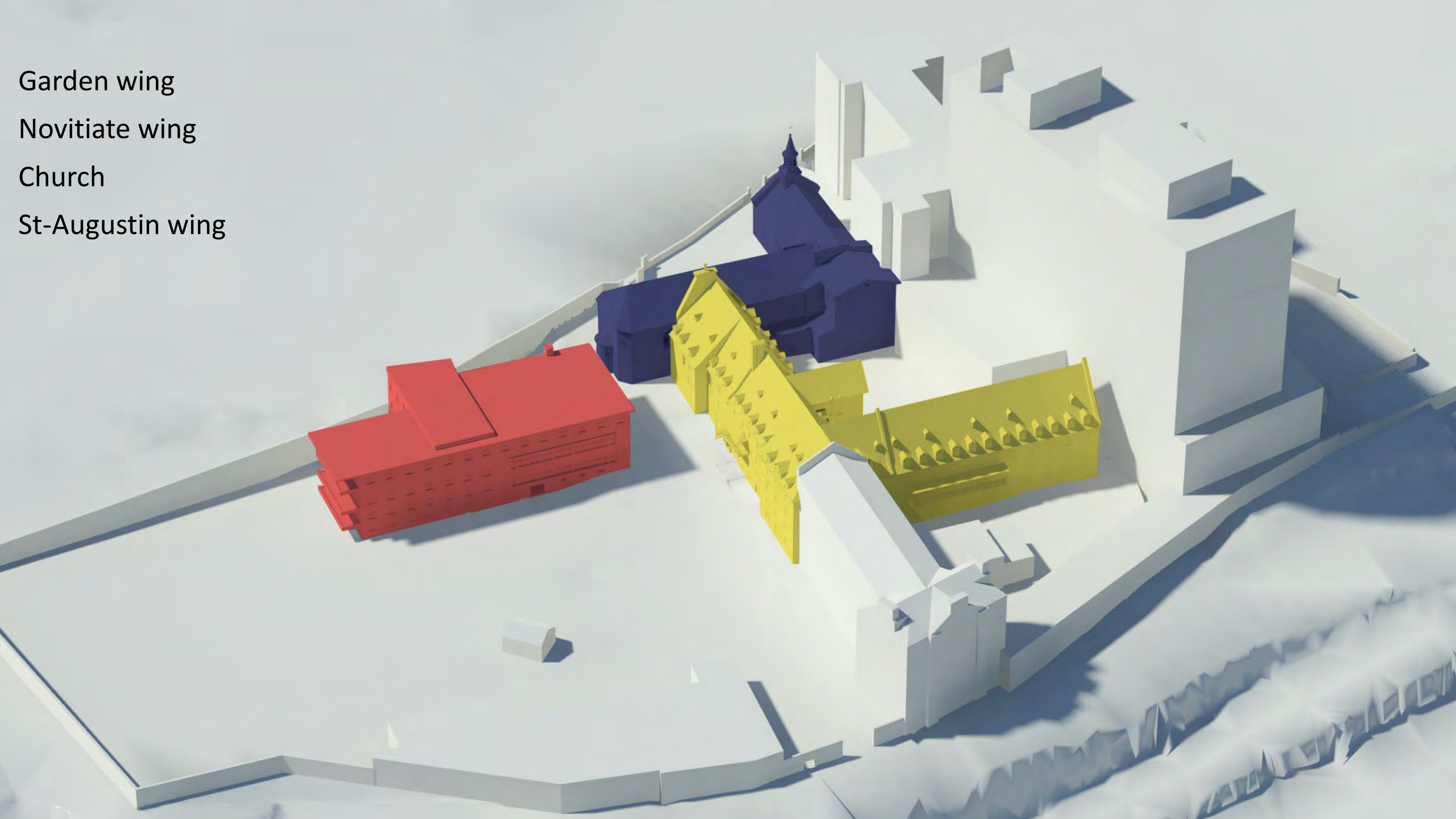

Honor Your Mother

AGUAS CALIENTES, PERU

Before journeying up to the Inca ruins on Machu Picchu, give your mother a call. Mother Earth, that is. At traditional "payment to the Earth" rituals at Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel (one of the National Geographic Unique Lodges of the World), a shaman helps guests honor Pachamama (Mother Earth) by burning a gift-wrapped package that includes coca leaves, a llama fetus, sweets, and confetti. The two-hour ceremony pays tribute to the earth (mountain gods). "I'm not a spiritual person, but when the shaman bundled things together and put them in the fire," says Noa Arce-Weil, who participated in the ritual this year, "I was moved." notgeolodges.com
