

Utility Billing FAQs

Q: Is there a minimum water, sewer, and refuse charge?

A: Yes, the minimum for water and sewer is based on an equivalent of 300 cu. ft., and refuse is based on type of service.

Q: How long do you hold the security deposit?

A: Twelve months of 'good payment', which means the account has been paid in full by the due date, or upon final billing.

Q: How do I terminate my service?

A: You can call or come into our office at least 24 hours prior to the final date of service you request. We will schedule a date and time if necessary for access to the meter to retrieve a final reading. We will also need a forwarding address to send the final bill.

Q: What happens to my security deposit when I move?

A: If the City still holds your deposit at the time your account goes final and you move outside our service area, we apply the deposit toward your final bill. If this results in a credit, we will issue a check and mail to your new address.

Q: Who do I call if I have a refuse question?

A: Contact Public Works at 440 775-7218.

Q: How do I recycle in Oberlin?

A: Contact the Recycling Coordinator at 440-935-0096 or visit the city's website at www.cityofoberlin.com.

Q: Can I receive my utility bill via e-mail?

A: Yes, go to www.cityofoberlin.com then to Utilities and click on the Email Billing. While there you can also sign up for automatic payments and go completely PAPERLESS.
